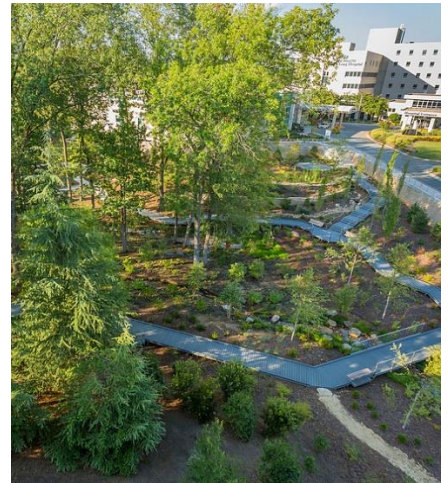


PLANT SCIENCE AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE SEMINAR SERIES
